What is your burning career question? Click on this icon to send it to us, and we will answer it in this column.

Q: I need all the help I can get to find a job, but I'm concerned about the cost of using a career coach. How can I justify this?

A: A good career coach will help you shorten the time it takes for you to get back to work. Getting back to work means that you will be earning a salary again. You should look at what it costs you every week you are not earning a salary. Compare this chart with what you were earning in your last position.

Salary	Weekly Pay Loss
\$60,000	\$1,155
\$80,000	\$1,540
\$100,000	\$1,925
\$140,000	\$2,690
\$160,000	\$3,075
\$200,000	\$3,845
